## Lucky Tendulkar Unlucky for World Cup.

The World Cup adorns a matchless charm about itself. The event has fascinated all age groups alike and has inspired the media and the big fighters in the markets to take advantage of its charm. The event was held for the first time in the year 1975. With the 10th World Cup around the corner in 2011 numerologist Arvind Dixit again makes a historic prediction that India can win the world but without Sachin Tendulkar playing in the Indian cricket team. Saurav Ganguly was also a successful captain. on 11th January 1992 he played the First OD for India. Saurav Ganguly was born on 8th July 1972. In 2003 it was the 8th World Cup which is in harmony with his date of birth number 8. It was his luck that made India reach the finals of World Cup 2003. It took him 11 years to reach the World Cup.

Mahinder Singh Dhoni was born on 7th July 1981. He played first OD on 23rd December 2004. In 2007 he got India the 20-20 World Cup. This came after playing for less than 3 years.

These are all the Captains having their birth number as 4,7 or 8. These people always benefit their country. Whereas the Combination for Tendulkar is 3,6 and 9. This is a combination rarely found and is very lucky but this luck favors the individual.

Tendulkar was born on 24th April 1973, he has played 5 world cups. It was on 18th December 1989 that he played the First World Cup for India. He has made maximum

centuries in One Day matches and Test Matches. Its his 20th year in Indian Cricket Team yet he still has to get a World Cup for India. In Dhoni's 20-20 Tendulkar did not play.
